

Instructions on "discarding"

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In our household, we **separate** packaging materials from common **waste** on a daily basis.

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We **fold** large pieces of packaging (e.g. cardboard boxes).

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We carefully **empty** packaging from **food remains**.

We **dispose** of packaging **loose** in the blue bins and **not tied-up in bin bags**.

BEWARE

We never throw common waste into the blue bins of packaging recycling.



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The Municipality is always at your disposal to inform you about anything concerning packaging recycling (e.g. the position of Blue Bins, the frequency of packaging material collection etc.)

What we dispose of in the Blue Bins



Plastic

packaging:

from water, soft drinks, oil, detergents, yoghurt, butter, toothpaste, shampoo, toiletries, plastic wrap, plastic bags and others



Paper

packaging:

from milk, juices, cereals, biscuits, pizza, detergents, cardboard packaging (e.g. from TVs, fridges) and others



Glass

packaging:

from alcoholic beverages, water, milk, juices, refreshments, wine, food jars and others



Aluminum and tinplate packaging:

from beer and soft drinks, cans of oil, coffee, milk, concentrated milk, tomato paste, pet food and others



What we do NOT dispose of in the Blue Bins



Apart from the many recyclable materials recovered through packaging recycling, there are other items which do not help it such as:

food remains, batteries, electric and electronic devices, construction materials, glass sheets, fabrics, tree branches, items made of wood or leather etc.
