




## **ROOTS OF CARE**

**Collective Action for Regeneration and Empowerment**

This is a youth-led project in Thessaloniki and Nessonas, Greece, that empowers young people to reclaim urban nature, build community resilience and foster a culture of collective care. It draws inspiration from vibrant urban agroecology and food forest initiatives, showing how underused green spaces can become inclusive.

It responds to social isolation, eco-anxiety, degraded urban spaces and the lack of youth voice in ecological futures. Through permaculture, regenerative education and participatory action, it empowers youth aged 14-30 to become local agents of care, regeneration and inclusion.




